

Changes to Processes for Maintaining/Regaining NRRPT® Practitioner Status Effective September 1, 2016

Changes Effective September 1, 2016

The NRRPT® Board of Directors has approved the following changes to improve the process for maintaining and regaining Practitioner status.

Registration Maintenance Program –

The Registration Maintenance Program’s **Active Professional Practice** category is revised to allow:

| Category | Points | Maximum Points For 5-Year Cycle |
|--|-------------|---------------------------------|
| Active Professional Practice (max. 4/year) | 1/100 hours | 20 |

A RRPT may regain currency in the Registration Maintenance program by:

- Completing a Registration Maintenance Worksheet **for the prior 5 years** showing a minimum of 20 points **OR**
- Retaking and passing the NRRPT® exam.

Dues –

A RRPT may become current on dues by paying all back dues owed **up to a maximum of 5 years** at the current annual dues rate.
